

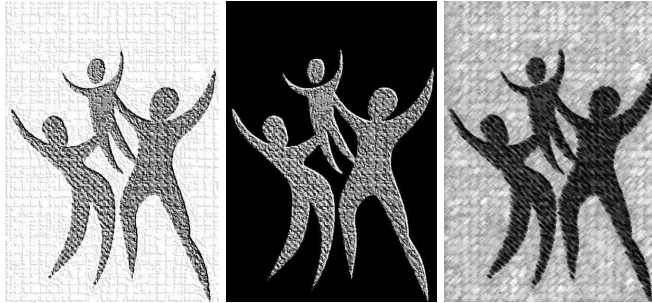

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A New and Improved Manual

This 2008 edition of the *Family Planning Program Manual for Oregon* is designed to serve as a reference and orientation tool for:

- Agencies receiving grants from the Family Planning Program as part of the state’s federally funded Title X Program
- Agencies participating in the Family Planning Expansion Project (FPEP)

In many instances, these agencies are identical. Others, however, may be participating only in FPEP. Guidelines for the Oregon Title X Program do not apply to those agencies. Even so, much of the material in this manual can be a useful resource for any agency seeking to provide a high quality family planning program and to understand the statewide system through which Oregonians receive services.

Combining the New & the Tried-and-True

In this revision, we’ve tried to keep all the things you liked about the earlier edition, while at the same time making it more current, convenient, user friendly, and concise.

As in the past, Section B features a complete copy of the *Program Guidelines for Project Grants for Family Planning Services* developed by the Office of Population Affairs, perhaps the most important reference source for Oregon’s Title X Program clinics.
