

Reports Generated from CVR Data

Explanations and Examples

Examples of many of the reports described here can be found immediately following the narrative.

When you submit your CVRs to Ahlers & Associates, the information on the form is added to a large database that stores each visit as a separate record. Your clinic or agency can then use the data in one of two ways: (1) Review the standard reports that Ahlers produces (descriptions follow in this appendix), or (2) create your own tabulations using the **Build a Report** feature on the Ahlers website (see Appendix D).

Standard Reports and Tables

Standard tables may not include all clients. The data are grouped into report batches, each of which includes a different slice of the total client population. You will need to determine which report batch meets your needs:

1. **Region X Management Reports** include all visits at Title X-funded clinics, regardless of the type of client or source of payment for the visit. These reports are generated for quarters, fiscal year, and calendar year.
2. **Oregon Management Reports** include all those visits for which FPEP was the source of payment. Visits at both Title X and FPEP-only clinics are included. These reports are generated for quarters, fiscal year, and calendar year.
3. **All Sources of Pay** reports include all visits to all sites, no matter what the source of payment. They are produced only for calendar year and fiscal year.

Coding on Tables

Tables are compiled quarterly, by calendar year, and/or by fiscal year, and are coded for easy identification. Some tables are not produced in all versions.

- **QL** = Quarterly table
- **AL** = Annual table (Jan 1 – Dec 31)
- **FL** = Fiscal table (July 1 – June 30)

Ahlers produces a wide variety of standard tables, available in any of the three report batches described above. Brief descriptions of the most frequently used reports follow.

Table 1: Services by Purpose of Visit

Table 1 lists the total number of medical counseling and referral services provided to clients for all their visits during a given period, segmented by purpose of visit as categorized in CVR Box 12. If a client was seen more than once during that time, all the services are counted.

The % (percent) column between each visit type is calculated only for those services required by Title X guidelines as part of a complete initial exam. (Remember, the annual exam is no longer required, but the percent column remains.) The percentage indicates how many times a particular service was performed within that visit category. Example: the **Initial Medical** column shows that 4,000 blood pressures were taken for the year; the next column specifies 85%. This means that blood pressure tests were conducted at 85 percent of initial exams.

Table 2: Client Counts by New/Continuing and Gender

Table 2 provides unduplicated client counts for assigned source of payment (CVR Box 9), federal poverty level (CVR Box 10), and race (CVR Box 6a), broken down by new clients, continuing clients, and gender. *Unduplicated* refers to the fact that a client is counted only once, even if she had more than one visit during the report time period. The last visit for that time period is the one described, regardless of whether the client is new or continuing.

Considerations: Numbers on the quarterly tables are cumulative for a calendar year (i.e., the second-quarter table includes data for that quarter and the first quarter). However, data on the calendar-year table *may differ* from those on the fourth-quarter table, because the calendar year table may include CVRs submitted after the fourth-quarter table was printed. Also, the total under ‘race’ might be larger than the total client number because clients are allowed to check more than one race.

Table 3: Unduplicated Client Count by Age

Table 3 provides data for assigned source of payment (CVR Box 9), federal poverty level (CVR Box 10), race (CVR Box 6A), and ethnicity (CVR Box 6) broken down into various age ranges. Age is determined to be the client’s age at the first visit of the quarter or year computed used the date of birth (CVR Box 4).

Table 4: Initial & Annual Clients, Poverty by Source of Pay

Table 4 compiles data for clients who had an initial visit or an annual visit. It tabulates clients by source of payment (CVR Box 9) and federal poverty level (CVR Box 10). The computer calculates the federal poverty level using the most current federal poverty guidelines, the monthly family income, and family size. These data apply solely to the reported period; they are **not** cumulative.

Table 5: Contraceptive Clients by Male/Female & Age

Table 5 shows clients’ exit methods of contraception — or reason for no method — (CVR Boxes 15A and 15B), broken down by gender and age. These data apply solely to the reported period; they are **not** cumulative.

Table 7: Theoretical Estimates of Pregnancies Averted

Table 7 shows the number of clients using each different contraceptive method before their visits (CVR Box 15A, Before Visit) and after their visits (CVR Box 15A, After Visit), by age (19 & under vs. 20 and over). It also lists the expected failure rate (per 1,000) for each method. In Table 7A, this information is used to produce a theoretical number of pregnancies averted, by subtracting the estimated number of pregnancies that would occur given clients' ending contraceptive methods from the estimated number that would have occurred if clients had kept their beginning contraceptive methods. The pregnancies averted number is also broken down into expected births, abortions, and miscarriages, based on the national frequency of each pregnancy outcome. This table is compiled for calendar and fiscal years; there is no quarterly version.

Table 12: Client Age by Type of Service

Table 12 shows the number of medical services (CVR box 13) provided to clients by client age. This table is only available in the Region X reports.

Table 13: Unduplicated Client Counts by Race/Ethnicity

Table 13 provides data for assigned source of payment (CVR Box 9) and federal poverty level (CVR Box 10) broken down by client ethnicity (CVR box 6) and race (CVR box 6a). This table is also only available in the Region X reports.

Table 26: Visits of New/Continuing Clients with a Pregnancy Test Performed

Table 26 provides information on age, race/ethnicity, poverty level, source of payment, and purpose of visit of clients who had a pregnancy test performed. Data are broken down by new/continuing status, by the outcome of test result and whether a positive pregnancy was planned or unplanned.
