New Chlamydia Test in Family Planning - Webinar

The Oregon Infertility Prevention Project (IPP)/Oregon Public Health Laboratory will soon use a different test for chlamydia. Clinics who currently use the Oregon PH Lab for their chlamydia tests will need to use different materials and procedures for collecting specimens for chlamydia screening. Other clinics may be interested in changing the lab they use for chlamydia screening. This training event will include discussion of the Aptima Combo 2 NAAT, new specimen collection options, specimen transportation and recommend new screening populations.

- Review and fill in the sterilization consent form completely and correctly

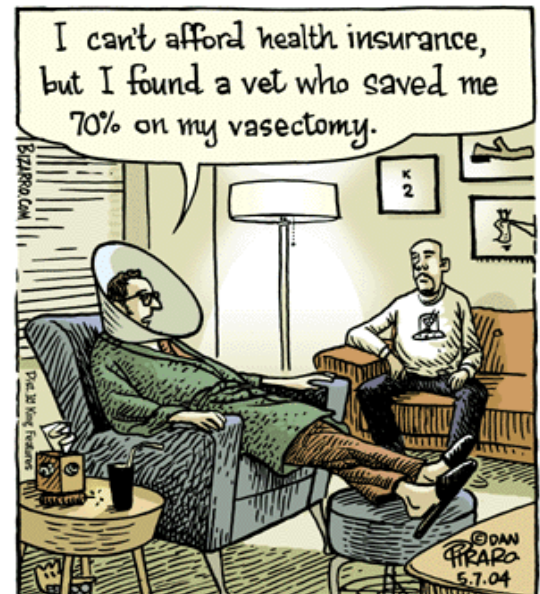
Additional opportunities to attend this training will be offered because the State Family Planning Program will be working to ensure that there is participation from every family planning agency that offers vasectomies.
